

## What Does an AODA Country Representative Do?

🌐 Serves as a local resource to integrate new AODA members into practice in the country.



🌐 Serves as an information base for ADA/AODA regarding country-specific practices.

🌐 Serves as a resource base to ADA/AODA help field inquiries regarding practice & educational opportunities abroad.

🌐 Serves as an expert resource to ADA members regarding practice in different countries.



🌐 Establishes relationships with key associations impacting practice.

🌐 Serves as a resource for referrals in collaboration with local dietetics professionals.



## Applying to become an AODA Country Representative

To be an AODA Country Rep you must:

- Be an AODA member.
- Know the nutrition issues in the country that you wish to represent.
- Be ready to actively network with local dietetic associations and other nutrition-related organizations.
- Be able to communicate regularly through e-mail.
- Be willing to write quarterly reports on your work as the Country Rep.
